- **First conditional. A possible situation in the future.**  
**If + Present simple + future (will/won't).**  
**Example: If it rains, we will cancel the trip.**
- **Second conditional. Hypothetical or unlikely situation.**  
**If + Past simple + would (wouldn't) + verb base form**  
**Example: If I won the lottery, I would travel a lot.**

- **Third conditional. Unreal past situations.**

**If + Past Perfect + would have (wouldn't have) + verb base form**

**Example: If they had left earlier, they wouldn't have missed the bus.**

- **Past Perfect: had + v. past participle**
